#### The Hayes information *(Highlighted text will be confirmed nearer the time)*

- The Hayes reception desk in the main entrance is usually staffed between 8.30 am and 10.00 pm. A Duty Manager is available from 7.30 am to 11.00 pm and overnight in case of emergency. They can be contacted by calling the number that will be left at Reception.
- All rooms are en-suite and are situated in **Lakeside**. (All the rooms in the main accommodation block are now called Lakeside. If it is raining, it is possible to wend your way through the building to an exit onto the covered walkway.
- Travel information is on the [website at the bottom of this page](#). If you are travelling by public transport, please note the useful tips in that document.
- There is plenty of parking at The Hayes and also two electric car charging points available in the main car park along the side of Lakeside (the first two on the left as you drive into the car park). Delegates need to pay a £10.00 deposit and they will receive £7.00 back when they return the key). It is not possible to pre-book the charging points.
- On arrival from 3pm, please register and collect your lanyard and key card from the **Main House Reception**. Key cards also open external doors. Please ensure that external doors close firmly behind you and do not let anyone into the building as you enter.
- Our main meeting room will be the **Main Conference Hall**.

- Your key cards do not give access to the meeting rooms so the planning team will take responsibility for opening and locking these rooms. It may be wise to ensure that you don't leave any valuables unattended in the meeting rooms in case they are left unlocked.
- If the fire alarm sounds, proceed to the Fire Assembly Point at the Main Conference Hall. This is not the Derbyshire Hall but the stand-alone building below the chapel and (if you are going uphill to the chapel) to the right of the building containing the dining room.) Please do not return to the building until the Duty Manager has confirmed it is safe to do so.
- First Aid facilities can be accessed at Reception. If you are on any medication/have allergies which A&E might need to know about should you be unfortunate enough to end up there, please ensure information is in your pocket or handbag. It is also always useful to have [an ICE entry in your phone](#) and if your phone locks itself, on the lock screen.
- There is wifi throughout The Hayes. When logging on, click wifi and then insert your email address and tick the terms and conditions box. This will enable you to a free three-day personal quota.
- There is a gift shop in the Main House that stocks a range of greeting cards, gifts, confectionery, postcards, toiletries, Christian books, Fair trade products etc and this is usually open during morning coffee and afternoon tea. Please note cash is only accepted for payments under £5, card payments should be used when over £5.
- The bar will be open for refreshments during evening break and at the end of the day. Please note that the bar can only accept card payments.
- There is a guest laundry, off the Lakeside reception, fitted with a washing machine, tumble dryer and ironing station. A TV room is available in Lakeside.
- On departure day (Thursday) - All rooms should be vacated by 9.15 am. Please turn off your radiator and close the windows before leaving your room. Return key cards to Main House reception. Luggage may be left in the Main House luggage store (located to the left of Main House reception desk). Please don't leave any personal belongings in the meeting room as it will not be locked during lunch.
- You will need to keep your lanyard if you are staying for lunch and wear it to be served in the dining room. Please remember to return them to Ben Aldous or any CTE staff member before you leave The Hayes.
- Please keep an eye on noticeboards, eg for the taxi/lifts offered list and other relevant information as we will be keeping announcements to a minimum.
- This is a paperless meeting. Bring with you anything you need printed out or have it ready on your tablet/laptop.
