






International Mission Statement

The Salvation Army, an international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church.

Its message is based on the Bible.

Its ministry is motivated by the love of God.

Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in his name without discrimination.

Articles of faith

1. **Bible** is 'the divine rule of Christian faith and practice'
2. **God** is the 'Creator, Preserver and Governor of all things' and 'the only proper object of religious worship'
3. **Trinity**: persons are 'undivided in essence and coequal in power and glory'
4. **Christ** is 'truly and properly God and truly and properly man'
5. **The Fall** leaves all humankind in need of salvation
6. **The Atonement** means 'whosoever will may be saved'

Articles of faith

7. Salvation is by ‘repentance towards God, faith in our Lord Jesus Christ and regeneration by the Holy Spirit’

8. ‘Justified by grace, through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ’

9. ‘Continuance in a state of salvation depends upon continued obedient faith in Christ’

10. Holiness: ‘it is the privilege of all believers to be wholly sanctified’

11. Last things: ‘the immortality of the soul’ – ‘the resurrection of the body’ – ‘the general judgment at the end of the world’
