- All bedrooms are en-suite.
- On arrival from 12 noon, please register at the Main House reception area and collect your lanyard.
- There is plenty of parking, and also two electric car charging points available, (clearly marked in front of the access doors to rooms 55/56 across the car park). You need to pay at Reception to obtain the key which should be returned (and the charger space vacated) as soon as possible.
- Key cards are **programmed to give access to your bedroom at 2.00 pm**. You may leave your luggage in the Main House luggage store, located in the Main House Lounge. Key cards also open external doors.
