History

• The Wesleyan Holiness Church in the UK was officially established in 1958.

 The WHC in the UK was formerly known as Pilgrim Holiness Church

 A merger in 1968 between the Wesleyan Methodist Church of America and the Pilgrim Holiness Church in Canada and the Caribbean.

Historical – Growth

 The early pioneers from the different Caribbean islands who came to Britain wanted to gather Pilgrims (Wesleyans) together.

• The first official service happened in an attic room in Balsall Heath, Birmingham in 1958.

 A call was put out to those in the Caribbean to specifically come and plant/start churches in the UK



Who we are

 Members originated from or are descendants of those from the different Caribbean islands (i.e. Barbados, Jamaica, Antigua, St Kitts and Nevis etc.)

 Part of our heritage is Women can be elected to take up senior positions (i.e. Superintendents)








