


## Where are the World's Ongoing Conflicts?

We currently live in one of the most peaceful eras in history, but that doesn't mean that there is an absence of violence.


Here's a look at 27 of the world's ongoing conflicts as of 2021.

Emission sectors that will be covered by NIR, among others:



Iron and steel production, non-ferrous metals (-56.4 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Public electricity and heat production (-47.7 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Road transportation, other transportation (-12.7 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Chemical industry (-11.7 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Commercial/residential sector (-10.7 Mt CO2-eq.)



Oil and natural gas production (-5.7 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)

Emission processes that will not be covered by NIR:



Use of bombs, missiles, artillery, mines, etc. (+0.28 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Use of petroleum products for military actions (+28.7 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Fires of petroleum storage depots (+5.4 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Fires of buildings and infrastructure objects (+18.1 Mt CO<sub>2</sub>-eq.)



Forest fires and fires of agricultural lands (+23.8 Mt CO2-eq.)


