Worship Resources

[Back to School with God](#) offers resources for worship to use at the start of the school year. The resources are produced by [Scripture Union Scotland](#), with partners. These resources might complement those produced specifically for Education Sunday. The school year in Scotland begins earlier than in England and Wales, so they are not written for the lectionary readings that are used on 13 September for Education Sunday.

The College of Preachers offers [sermon notes](#) that may be helpful for those preaching on Education Sunday. Although you need to register to receive these, registration is free of charge and allows you to download two articles.

The Salvation Army has [resources](#) to help you pray for schools in your community.

The Catholic Church has produced its own [resources](#) for Education Sunday.

[Further Education Sunday](#) is celebrated in May. You may like to use some of this year's resources to remember this important part of the education sector in your Education Sunday service.

Resources to help you engage with education in your community

The Children's Ministry Network (a network of Churches Together in Britain and Ireland) has produced a [resource](#) to help churches host visits from schools. This offers a lot of useful advice for building relationships with local schools.
