 - And more..

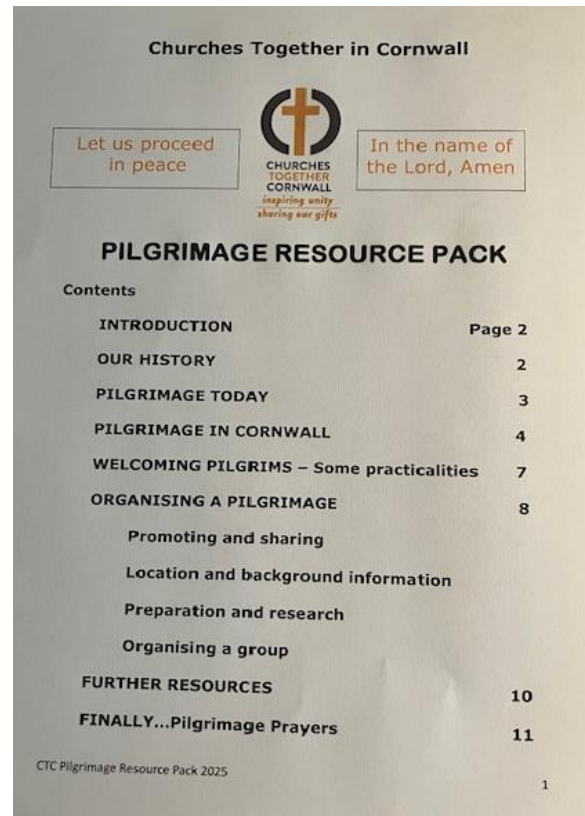

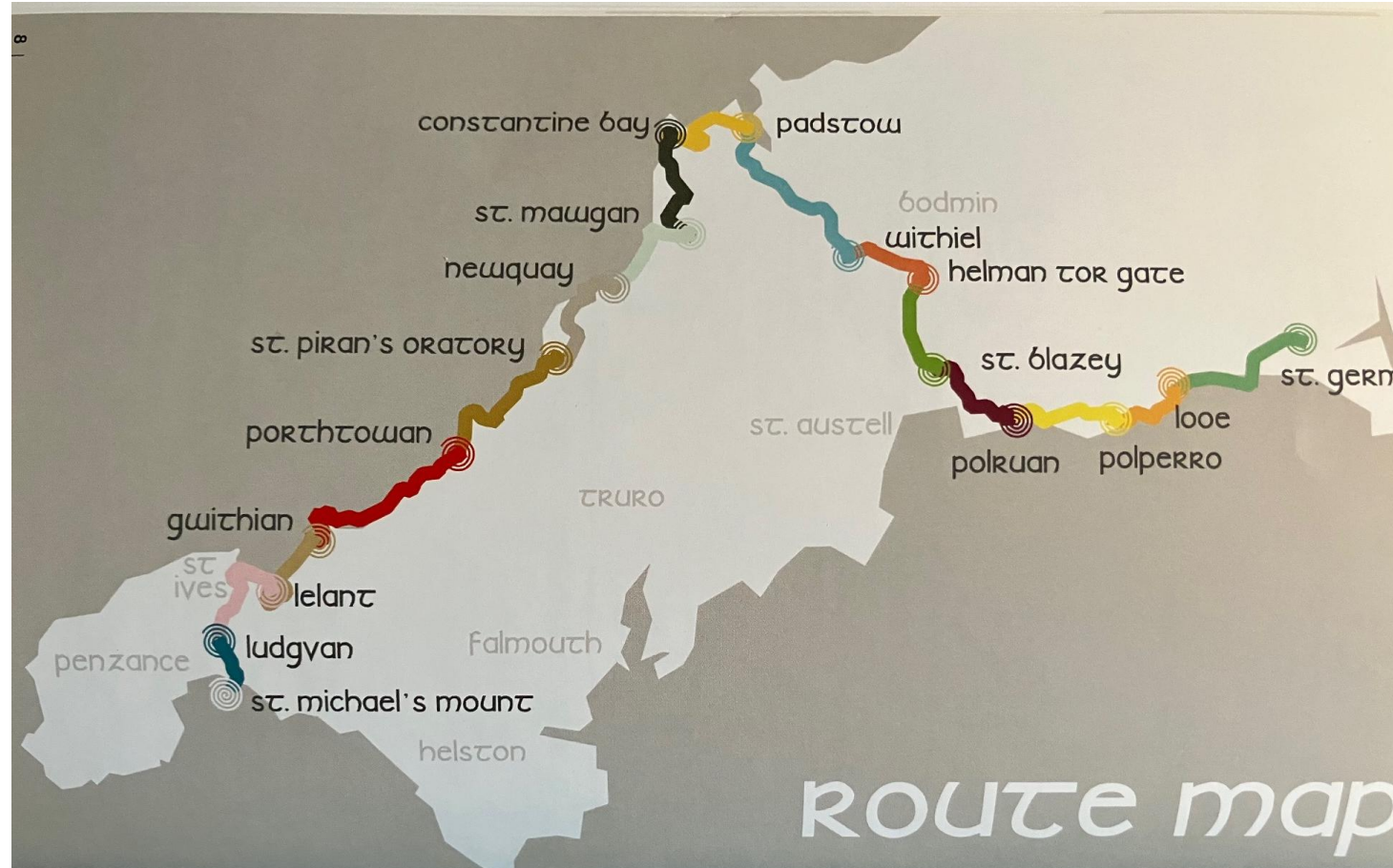
